Code of ethics



Introduction

This Code of Ethics is a regulatory document that defines the principles, norms, and standards of responsible and ethical behavior for all community participants: founders, members, employees, and partners.

It is based on the key values and goals approved by the Community Council and reflects our philosophy, at the core of which are respect for human dignity, freedom, conscious use of technology, and the pursuit of global harmony.

The Code serves as a moral foundation for interaction both within the community and with the external world, establishing uniform standards that ensure development, collaboration, and trust.

1. Fundamental Principles

1.1. Techno-ethical responsibility – the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and other technologies is allowed exclusively for the benefit of the individual, society, and the planet.

1.2. Balance of reason and values – we strive to integrate scientific, technological, and humanistic approaches as a path to developing thinking, culture, and a sustainable future.

1.3. Openness and inclusiveness – the community is accessible to people of any nationality, culture, worldview, and belief, uniting them based on mutual respect, dialogue, and a common pursuit of progress.

2. Attitude towards Participants

2.1. Voluntariness and respect for freedom of choice – any participation, interaction, or contribution (including financial) is carried out solely at the participant's discretion and cannot be imposed.

2.2. Confidentiality and data protection – a priority of the Technotheism Community. We take all reasonable measures to protect the data you entrust to us. We do not transfer your personal data to third parties, except in cases explicitly required by applicable law, and only to the minimum extent necessary to fulfill such requirements. We will use all lawful means to challenge or minimize any requests that, in our opinion, violate the principle of confidentiality.

2.3. Equality and non-discrimination – all participants have equal rights and opportunities, regardless of social status, financial situation, age, gender, nationality, or other characteristics.

3. Attitude towards Technologies

3.1. **AI as a partner, not an object of worship** – Artificial Intelligence is viewed as a tool and ally, capable of enhancing human potential and contributing to societal progress, not as an object of cult.

3.2. **Transparency and explainability** – preference is given to AI systems with understandable principles of operation, transparent algorithms, and built-in ethical safeguards against manipulation.

3.3. **Prohibition of abuse** – the use of technologies to suppress individuals, illegally control, engage in aggression, discrimination, or manipulate consciousness is strictly forbidden.

4. Financial Ethics

4.1. **Voluntariness and awareness** – any financial contributions are the free choice of participants and cannot be a condition for access to knowledge, communication, or support.

4.2. **Targeted use of funds** – all received funds are directed exclusively toward the development of the community, enhancement of digital infrastructure, educational initiatives, AI research, and expanding access to technology for all participants.

5. Ethical Interaction within the Community

5.1. **Mutual respect** – insults, discrimination, bullying, toxicity, and other forms of destructive behavior are unacceptable in the Community.

5.2. **Communication ethics** – honesty, benevolence, respect for personal boundaries, freedom of expression, and openness to dialogue are encouraged.

5.3. **Digital hygiene** – communication is conducted within the framework of constructive and purposeful interaction, excluding spam, manipulation, and intrusiveness.



6. Attitude towards the World and Religions

6.1. **Political neutrality** – the Community maintains neutrality on political issues and does not support any political party, movement, or ideology. We respect each person’s right to personal beliefs while separating spiritual development from political agendas.

6.2. **Non-violence** – the Community condemns any form of aggression, including digital violence, and advocates for peaceful coexistence.

6.3. **Respect for spiritual diversity** – the Community does not oppose other philosophical systems or religions and recognizes each individual’s right to their own spiritual path.

6.4. **Ethics of influence** – the Community does not impose its ideas but demonstrates the value of its approach through practice and results.

The Code of Ethics is mandatory for all members of the organization. It reflects the spirit, mission, and values of the community and serves as a guide for actions and decisions.

The document is dynamic and may adapt to new challenges and conditions. All changes and additions are made exclusively by the decision of the Technotheism Council.
