**Regulation on Prohibited Topics and
Restrictions on Statements and Publications of
Community Members**

Introduction:

The Community strictly adheres to ethical and moral principles aimed at creating a safe and constructive environment for communication and interaction among members. This document establishes clear boundaries of permissible and impermissible actions of Community members, as well as minimizes possible provocations and abuses.

1. General Provisions

1.1. Objectives of the Document:

- Minimize legal, ethical, and reputational risks for the Community.
- Maintain a healthy, constructive, and respectful atmosphere in all forms of interaction.
- Eliminate the spread of ideas, statements, and actions that contradict the mission and values of the organization.

1.2. Scope of Application:

These rules are mandatory for compliance by all members, moderators, administrators, speakers, leaders of local and online communities, as well as any persons acting on behalf of or in the interests of the Community. They apply to all formats of communication, including public events, social networks, personal and group correspondence, publications, comments, and speeches.

2. Prohibited Topics and Types of Propaganda

2.1. LGBT Propaganda

- Any direct or hidden propaganda of LGBT is strictly prohibited, including the use of symbols, attributes, clothing, gestures, and slang.

2.2. Racism and Discrimination

- Any manifestations of racism, as well as discrimination on racial, national, or ethnic grounds, are strictly prohibited.
- Publications or statements inciting interethnic hatred or intolerance are banned.

2.3. Political Propaganda

- Any form of political campaigning or support of political parties, ideologies, and candidates is prohibited.

2.3. Drugs and Psychoactive Substances

- Any propaganda of drugs and psychoactive substances is strictly prohibited, including positive mentions, approvals, and justifications of the use of any substances, even those permitted in some countries.

2.4. Religious Confrontation

- It is forbidden to oppose any religions to each other, as well as to declare the superiority or inferiority of any religion or lack of faith, which may lead to conflict or division within the Community.

2.5. Other Prohibited Topics

- Immoral and illegal actions are prohibited, including fraud, financial pyramids, suicide, self-harm, anti-scientific and pseudoscientific ideas, immoral behavior, and propaganda of violence.

3. Control and Responsibility

3.1. Control Mechanism

- The Community carries out regular monitoring of members' activity on all platforms.
- Members of the Community are obliged to immediately report violations to a special email address posted on the official website of the Community.

3.2. Response to Violations

- The Administration undertakes to promptly review reports of violations.
- Confirmed violations may entail expulsion of the offender from the Community, as well as transfer of materials to law enforcement agencies.
- Informants' anonymity is guaranteed upon their request.

3.3. Address for Reporting Violations

- The email address for reporting violations is posted on the official website of the Community.

4. Responsibility of the Community and Members

- The Community is not responsible for publications, statements, or actions of members made on their own behalf without prior approval.
- Each member is personally responsible for their words, publications, and actions, being aware of possible legal and reputational consequences.

5. Final Provisions

- This document comes into force from the moment of its approval by the Community's management.
- The Administration reserves the right to periodically review and update the provisions of the document.
